One of the areas that we are focusing on this year is the quality of our welcome, and how we can improve this. As we see the joy that Mary Magdalene and the disciples have in sharing the news of the Resurrection with others and bringing them into relation with Jesus, it seems a wonderful season to pray for our own commitment to welcoming those who come to our church and giving them the best possible experience of the parish and encounter with Christ. As part of our welcome, we have developed a gift pack to give to new parishioners, with a number of lovely items to welcome them to the parish as well as information about parish life and groups. One of the other things that we're moving forward with is in expanding our teams of welcomers. We'd therefore love to expand our team of welcomers so as to be able to have more capacity, and to be able to better identify and welcome newcomers to our parishes. Is this something that you might consider being part of? Your warmth and welcome might make all the difference to someone's first experience of our parishes.
