On Tuesday 17 September at 6pm, we will be celebrating a major event in the life of our Syro-Malabar rite community. Until now they have has the status of a Proposed Mission. Thanks to the hard work of Fr Rajesh, the Trustees and community, they have been building up the structures and life over the last couple of years so that they are now at the point where they can be formally established as a Mission. Until 2022, they were served by a visiting priest and had Mass once a month. They will shortly be moving to having Mass every Sunday and increasing the number of weekday Masses they celebrate. They have also established a wonderful pastoral structure, with family units, catechesis, women's forum and youth activities. On 17 September, His Beatitude Major Archbishop Mar Raphael Thattil, Head and Father of the Syro-Malabar Church worldwidetogether with Mar Joseph Srampickal, the Bishop of the Syro-Malabar Eparchy of Great Britain, will be coming to St George's to formally declare them a Mission, with the new name of Mar Sebastianos Syro-Malabar Mission. All Latin-rite parishioners are warmly invited to this special celebration. Please keep this new stage very much in your prayers, and pray for the continued development of the Mission, so that it may get its own Church and Presbytery and so formally become a Parish.

I WANT TO SEE GOD: our group reading Blessed Marie-Eugene's masterwork helping us to go deeper in our life of prayer has finished looking at the introductory chapters of the book. We will begin looking at the first part of the spiritual life on 24 September and subsequent Tuesday evenings from 6.15pm-7.15pm in St George's Rectory. Newcomers are welcome.

THE BISHOPS OF ENGLAND & WALES: have asked us to mark this day as *Evangelii Gaudium Sunday*. It gives us the opportunity to reflect on the great mandate we have been given by the Risen Lord to evangelise the whole world. "Go therefore and make disciples of all nations," the Lord commissions, as we hear in Matthew 28:19. They have chosen the theme 'Growing as missionary disciples'. We are asked to pray for our parish communities, that they would become intentionally missionary in their life and witness. A second collection will also be taken to support the work of the Bishops' Conference Mission Directorate.

MAMRE: We are launching this new monthly opportunity for all parishioners, young and old, to come together for a time to be nourished and grow together in faith and friendship. We've decided to call it Mamre, the place where Abraham ate with God. Every third Sunday of the month, beginning this Sunday the 15 September, we'll be having a parish family morning in the Taunton Catholic Centre. For young families we will provide a themed interactive family experience, while for older parishioners there will be opportunities for faith formation, followed by a catered lunch for everyone. It's not too late to register your interest-please let the Parish Office know.

40 HOURS WITH THE LORD: we will be having 40 hours of Eucharistic Adoration from 5am on Friday 8 November to 9pm on Saturday 9 November. There will be times of silent adoration as well as led devotions and times of praise and worship. We'll also be offering a programme of talks about the Eucharist
