On this Remembrance Sunday, we remember especially those who have died in war. We pray very specially for those from our own parishes who died in the First and Second World Wars, and are commemorated in our war memorials. I find it very poignant to read their stories and learn more about their lives in the beautiful booklet that was produced for us by Ray Stokes. A copy is available on our website for anyone who hasn't read this and would be interested in doing so. During this month of November we remember more generally all our loved ones who have died, and those who have no one to pray for them. We have a number of opportunities to pray for them. You are invited to record their names in our books of remembrance, so that we can pray for them at Masses during this month. We'll also be having the blessing of our memorial plot at St George's and the blessing of graves at the cemetery. I have some grave candles available for anyone who would like these. I always find it particularly poignant to pray at the graves of my predecessors, many of whom are buried in the cemetery. As we give thanks for the priests and parishioners who built our churches and spiritual community, I feel very powerfully the bond of communion we have with the saints in heaven and the souls in purgatory. As always, if you would like a Mass offered for a particular intention, whether for someone living or who has died, please do feel free to contact the parish office to book this in. My thoughts and prayers are particularly with all those who are grieving the loss of a loved one at this time.

NEW LECTIONARY DAY: At the beginning of Advent, we will start using the new lectionary with improved translations of the Biblical readings used at Mass. CATHOLIC SOCIAL TEACHING AS FORMATION FOR MISSION:

Join Jason Charewicz from the Department of Adult Education for an introductory Catholic Social Teaching workshop. Come to learn how Catholic Social Teaching fits within the ancient tradition of Catholic moral theology, serves as a bridge between our faith and our neighbours of other traditions, and how Catholic Social Teaching forms us to be missionary disciples in the 21st century. The evening will begin in prayer, and be a mix of presentation and group-discussion workshops. It will take place Thursday, 21 November at St George's, Taunton, from 19:00-21:00 (refreshments from 18:30).
