We are continuing to focus this year on how we best support those who are isolated or lonely for different reasons. Following the success of our session last Sunday looking at how we best support those living with dementia and their carers, we are running a session on Sunday 9 February looking at the spirituality of those living with dementia. This will take place in the parish centre after the 9.15am Mass at St George's. We'll use the beautiful 'It's still me Lord' resources produced by the Catholic Social Action Network which feature Fr Michael Gamble, the brother of one of our parishioners. I've been struck this week by the poignancy of conversations with a couple of people who have shared the isolation they've experienced through loss of hearing. I met this week with a specialist church sound engineer to look at the systems in our churches, to see if there was anything we could do to improve the sound quality in our parishes. The system at St Teresa's is particularly problematic with many people struggling to hear and the loop system not always working effectively. It turns out that the loop system we have installed is really for environments like banks and not designed for buildings of this size as it only has a short range of about a metre, so we are looking to upgrade this, as well as the speakers. At the Taunton Catholic Centre, we are looking at installing a loop system so that hearing aid users can more easily participate in parish events and activities.
