Very often we see those who are sick or housebound primarily as recipients of the ministry of others, such as the ministers who bring them communion, but the beautiful church document *Christifideles Laici* invites us to see things differently. "The Lord addresses his call to each and every one. *Even the sick are sent forth as labourers into the Lord's vineyard:* the weight that wearies the body's members and dissipates the soul's serenity is far from dispensing a person from working in the vineyard. Instead the sick are called to live their human and Christian vocation and to participate in the growth of the Kingdom of God in a *new and even more valuable manner*." Those who are sick or housebound have a crucial place at the heart of our parish, through their prayer and witness to the presence of Christ in the midst of their sufferings. We pray for and with them today, as well as for the wonderful work of the SVP who organise today's celebration.
