The Church honours the Exaltation of the Holy Cross every year on September 14th. Suffering is not glorified for its own sake by this feast but it points to the mystery that life has been given to the world through the Cross. In John 3:13–17, Jesus tells Nicodemus, "The Son of Man must be lifted up, that whoever believes in him may have eternal life." So, the Cross is not only a sign of sacrifice but also of hope: it reveals the depth of God's love for us: "For God so loved the world that he gave his only Son."

The early Christians understood this well. St. John Chrysostom wrote that the Cross is "the trophy of victory, the downfall of demons, the weapon against sin." What once symbolized humiliation and death has been transformed into a sign of triumph and life. In the Cross, we see God's power working through what appears weak.

We are invited to lift high the Cross in our own hearts, by this feast. We all carry burdens, wounds, and struggles. The Cross does not take them away, but it teaches us how to carry them with faith and love, trusting that God can bring new life even from suffering. To venerate the Cross is to say yes to God's love, even in the most difficult moments. Looking upon Christ crucified, we are reminded that His love is stronger than sin, stronger than death, and it leads us to resurrection.
