Reflecting on Luke 17:11–19, the image of the ten lepers calling out to Jesus from a distance is very striking. They are all healed yet only the Samaritan returns to give thanks. This is a moment that penetrates the heart, reminding us of how often we receive mercy from God yet forget to offer our gratitude. It was thanksgiving that made the Samaritan's faith complete. Turning back toward Jesus, he turned toward God; finding a wholeness in gratitude that went beyond physical restoration. Humility in gratitude illumines **this week's reading from King's**, where Naaman, after washing in the Jordan, is cleansed of his leprosy. Like the Samaritan, Naaman's healing opens his eyes to the living God. His first impulse is thanksgiving and worship—a response born from awe at divine mercy. These stories remind us that true faith doesn't end with receiving God's gifts; it deepens when we recognize the Giver.
