'Follow me, and I will make you fishers of men.'

This is one of the best one-liners in scripture. Notice the first part of the phrase: "I will make you." This is counter to the culture's prevailing view that we are self-made, that we invent and define our own reality. Jesus puts this lie to bed. We learn from him that its God who acts, and if we give ourselves to his creative power, he will make us something far better than we ever could.

But how does God recreate us?

God recreates us in the Truth, Jesus Christ himself. 'I am the way, and the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.'

"Jesus Christ, is the place where we recognize the truth of God the Father, while at the same time we discover ourselves known by Him as sons in the Son, called to the same destiny of full life." Pope Leo
God recreates us in the Son. By Jesus' death and resurrection, we are recreated back into the heart of the Father, recreated back to love himself.

Sometimes we tend to think, that God has created us and left us to just get on with it, but that's not true. God is always with us; all it takes is to gather some courage and call on him.

The work of creation is the work of the holy Trinity, the living God and so this work continues even today, the blessed Trinity is creating us each day so that we are fully charged with Divine Love, because it is this love that enables us to be something far better than we ever could.

This Sunday lets ponder especially on the Gospel Acclamation:

'Jesus proclaimed the gospel of the Kingdom,
and healed every affliction among the people.'

Let's take a minute, invite God in our affliction, invite him to recreate that which needs the medicine of love and renew our trust in Him, so that we give ourselves fully to the God of all creation.
